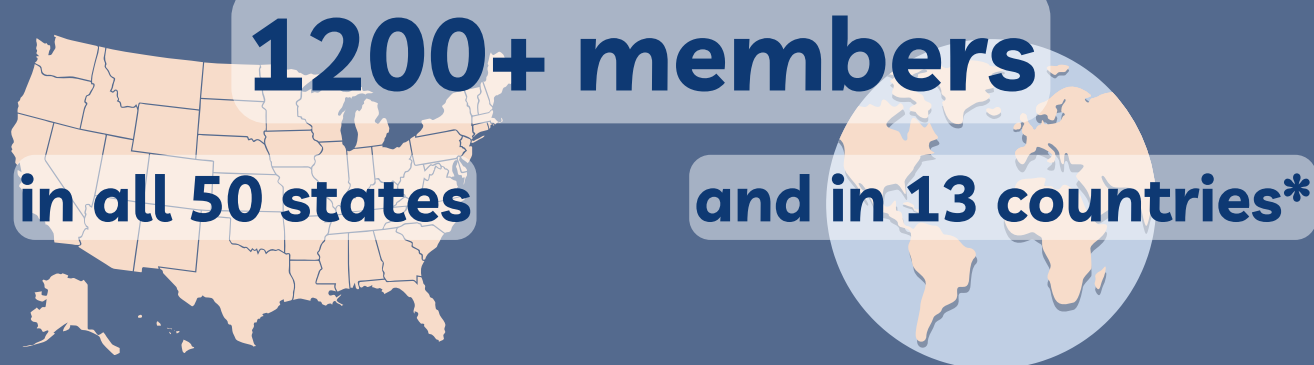

January 2025, we organized the **largest, most visible Latter-day Saint presence ever** at both the national March for Life in Washington, D.C. and the Utah March for Life (where thousands of friends of all faiths make their most united and largest pro-life statement of the year).

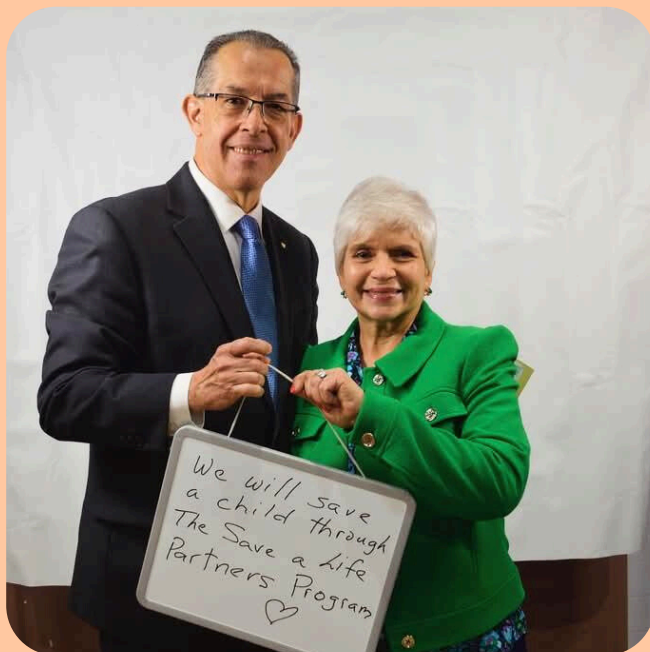
Ward clothing and diaper drive for Roseville Pregnancy and Health in California.

Baby shower hosted by a ward in Utah for a mom who chose life.

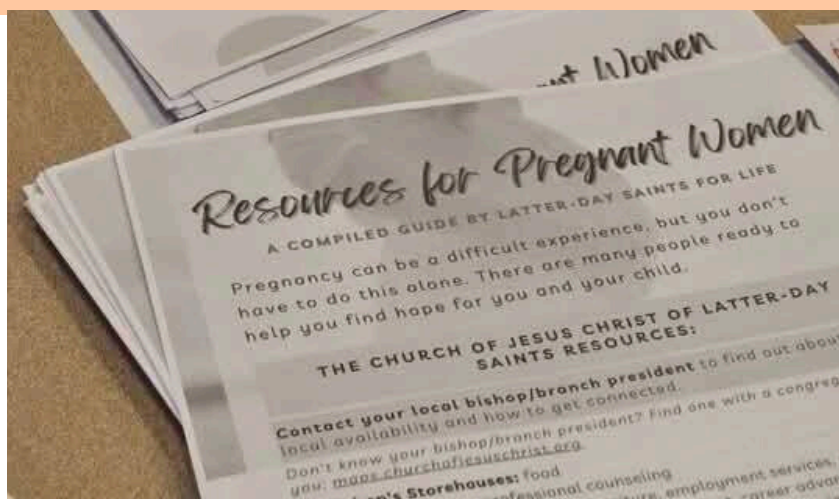




At our conference, we invited everyone to choose and commit to some form of pro-life service. Look for their commitments interspersed throughout the report!
